In small groups, children will further explore the story by using the Tales Toolkit to discuss the characters, setting, problem and solution.

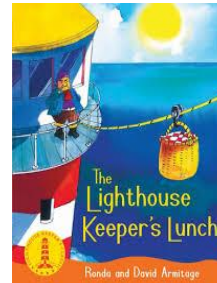
Physical Development
