




<u>Nursery</u>

Wiggle me into a Squiggler is designed for the early stages of mark making and physical development used in writing. This year, children will begin to develop both gross and fine motor skills through making patterns.

<u>Reception</u>

Squiggle Whilst you Wiggle and Squiggle me into a Writer move on to more advanced mark making and letter formation. In Reception, children learn letter formation through the use of Little Wandle Letter formation rhymes. These are introduced to the children as they learn each grapheme. In Reception children learn to write letters separately (not joined up). When the child's letter formation is accurate, joins are then to be introduced in the Summer term of Year 1 or at the beginning of Year 2.
