#### Communication, Language and Literacy

#### Core Book- The Gruffalo

The children will take part in an outdoor walk through of the story, looking for the characters until they come across 'The Gruffalo'. We will share the book every morning to become familiar with the story and encourage the children to join in with the repeated refrains.

We will discuss the story setting by looking at the pictures in the book using describing words to expand our vocabulary.

We will discuss the sequence of the story by modelling the language beginning, middle and end. We will further support the children with this concept by sequencing pictures of the key events at the beginning, middle and end of the story.

On the final day of this topic, we will talk about key events of the story and discuss our favourite part of the story in talking partners. We will then share this with the group with adults supporting and encouraging the children to respond in full sentences to encourage their communication skills.

Phonics focus: blending three syllable words, split vowel cvc words and on set and rime cvc words.

#### Mathematical Development

We will be learning to:

Compare sets of up 1-4 Gruffalo images by subitising (recognising by sight) when the images in each set are the same or similar in size or type e.g. compare 3 Gruffalo's and 2 Gruffalo's

Compare quantities using language: 'more than', 'fewer than' and 'less than'.

Compare two groups of objects, saying when they have the same number.

### PSE Development

Cosmic kids 'Room On Gruffalo' yoga.


Circle times to talk about their feelings in more detail e.g. "I am feeling happy because ...".

#### Physical Development

We will be supporting the children to: Develop their pencil grip and control to draw a Gruffalo and Mouse in our guided drawing sessions. Making dens for the characters in the outdoor area using fabric, logs, crates, wooden blocks etc. Manipulating dough to make snakes.
