

Key Vocabulary	
God	A superhuman spirit or being that is worshipped.
Jew	A Jew is one who practices the Jewish religion, Judaism.
Shabbat	Shabbat is a festive day when Jews exercise their freedom from the regular labours of everyday life.
Challah	Egg-rich yeast-leavened bread that is usually braided or twisted before baking.
Kippah	A skullcap worn by Orthodox Jewish men.
Shema	A liturgical prayer, prominent in Jewish history and tradition, that is recited daily at the morning and evening services and expresses the Jewish people's faith in and love of God.
