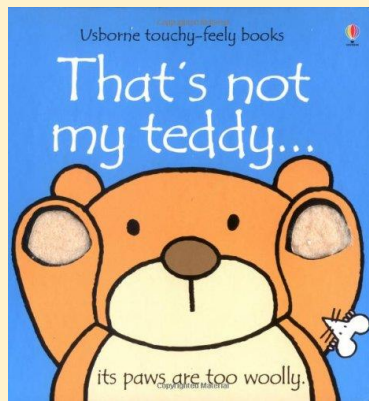


### Key Book Cover Facts

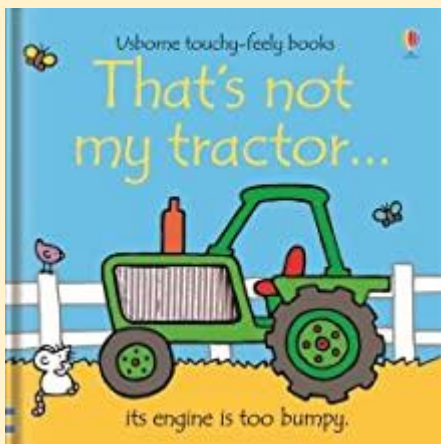

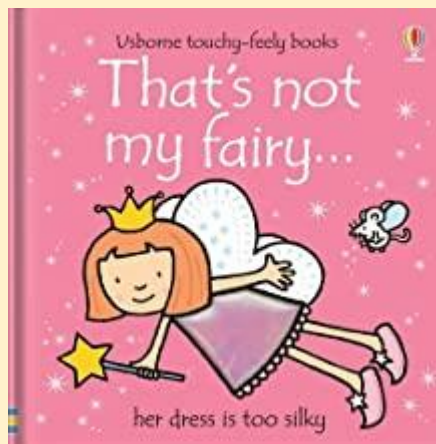
### Using Textures

### Key Vocabulary

**Collage** Artwork made by sticking materials onto a surface.

**Texture** How an object or image feels. Images may be created to look like they have a different texture.

**Overlap** Stick one piece slightly over the top of another.
