Focus: Poetry

Text: A ticket to Kalamazoo

Whilst exploring the collection of poems in the text, the children will explore and identify rhyme, create their own rhyming sentences, create, publish and perform poetry within the classroom, explore alliteration, similes, onomatopoeia and the use of commas through shape poems, acrostic poems, free verse poetry and riddles.

Spellings will continue to be based on the children's Read Write Inc phonics book each week.

Phonics



Children will continue daily phonics sessions to learn set 3 sounds and recap those in set 1 and 2 whilst reading and recognising these in words to develop fluency. Sessions will include reading a text at an appropriate level, answering questions, writing and editing sentences.
