Being Me in My World - Reception

Overview

The children talk about how they have similarities and differences from their friends and how that is OK. They begin recognising and managing their feelings, identifying different ones and the causes these can have. The children talk about working with others and why it is good to be kind and use gentle hands. They discuss children's rights, especially linked to the right to learn and the right to play and talk about what it means to be responsible.
