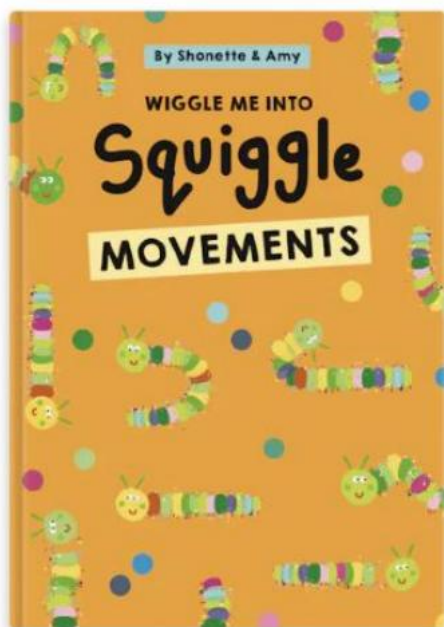

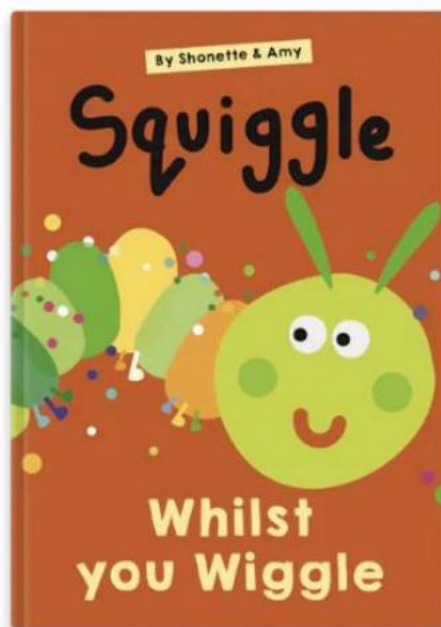

Ringway EYFS Handwriting Progression

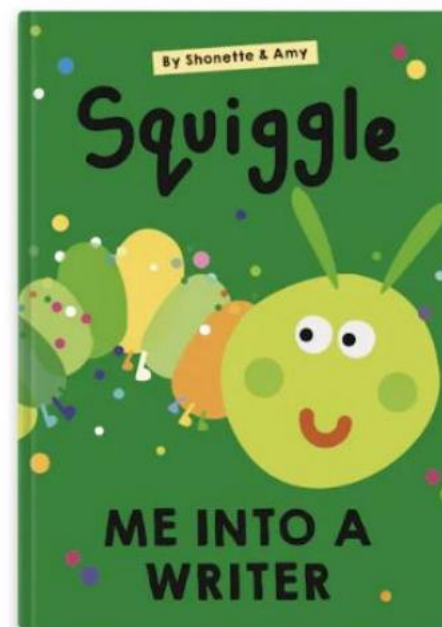
At Ringway, we value the importance of securing a firm foundation for Handwriting skills in the Early Years. We focus on developing gross and fine motor skills through a range of planned and purposeful enhancements to continuous provision and in adult-led sessions in order to fully prepare our children with the core strength, co-ordination and control they need when writing. We use the Squiggle Early Learning programme, a developmental approach to early writing that uses neurological and physiological movements to create marks. There are 3 stages that our children follow through their journey in Nursery and Reception.

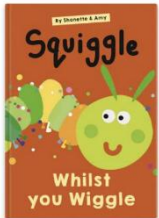
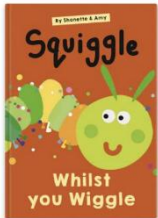
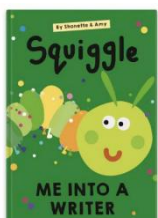
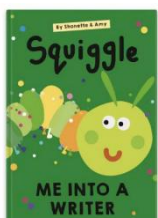
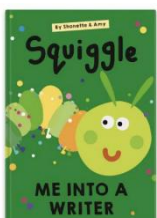
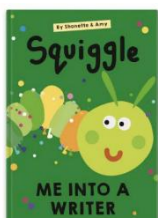
Nursery

Wiggle me into a Squiggle is designed for the early stages of mark making and physical development used in writing. This year, children will begin to develop both gross and fine motor skills through making patterns.

Reception

Squiggle Whilst you Wiggle and Squiggle me into a Writer move on to more advanced mark making and letter formation. In Reception, children learn letter formation using Read Write Inc Letter formation rhymes. These are introduced to the children as they learn each grapheme. In Reception children learn to write letters separately (not joined up yet). When the child's letter formation is accurate, joins are then to be introduced in Key Stage 1.
