Dear Parents/ Carers,

Welcome back to the final half term of this school year.

Children have had an incredibly busy summer term so far and June will see our final assessments of the year completed then we have an exciting few weeks planned with many trips, parties, discos and sports days being organised - please familiarise yourself with all the important dates provided below.

# **Phonics/ Multiplication screening checks**

**Year 1** will be taking their Phonics screening check **WB 12th June**. Those children in **Year 2** who did not meet the threshold last year, will also have the opportunity to repeat this on these dates.

Year 4 will be taking their Multiplication check WB 5th June - Friday 16th June.

Attendance and punctuality is vital on these dates.

### **Transition Day/ Morning**

On Tuesday 4th July, children will move up to their new classes for the morning and meet their new staff for next academic year. Please bring children to their normal doors and their current teacher will take them to their new class once the registers have been taken.

Year 6 will spend the day in their new secondary school. Students/ families are to make their own way there and back.

## **Sports Day/ Sponsor Week**

In the week commencing 10th July, your child will be taking part in their annual sports day events. We will also be carrying out a number of sponsored activities in order to raise money for school resources. The sponsored events will take place within their year group (each teacher will send out further information closer to the date).

#### **School Uniform**

#### School uniform consists of the following:

- White polo shirt
- Purple jumper or cardigan
- Grey trousers/skirt/pinafore/shorts
- Purple gingham summer dress
- Black school shoes/plain black school trainers with black soles (no large distinctive logos)
  Boots can be worn in winter months these must be plain black, ankle height and with no heel.
- Wellies (optional)

• One small watch and a pair of stud earrings (no other jewellery or smart watches permitted). For health and safety reasons, children must be able to remove their own earrings.

#### PE Uniform:

Our PE uniform consists of:

- Plain white t-shirt
- Plain black shorts or jogging pants
- Plain black hoody (optional)
- Black trainers (as plain as possible) or suitable black footwear for outdoor PE sessions.

We have a selection of pre-loved uniform in school, please contact the school office if you would like to come in and look through this. We will also display this outside, at home times, a few times over the next half term.
