Learning Outcomes

- To make sense of beliefs – to talk about people who belong to groups and why they are important to them.
- To look at symbols of belonging, for example, baptismal candles (Christians).
- To look at different ways people express their belonging within faith communities.
- To understand what Jesus and other religious leaders taught about loving other people.

Key Vocabulary

God	A superhuman spirit or being that is worshipped.
Christian	A person who has received Christian baptism or is a believer in Christianity:
Muslim	a follower of the religion of Islam:
Baptism	the Christian religious rite of sprinkling water on to a person's forehead or of immersing them in water, symbolizing purification or regeneration and admission to the Christian Church
Belonging	an affinity for a place or situation.
Valuable	a thing that is of great worth.
Symbol	a thing that represents or stands for something else.

Topic Overview

Tell stories to show everyone is valuable (The Lost Sheep).
Introduce Christian baptism and compare this with a welcoming ceremony from one other religion.
To find out about times when people from different religions work together, for example, Remembrance Day.
