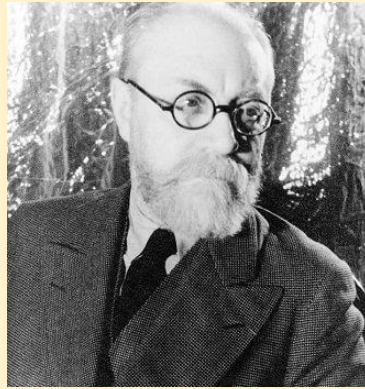


Key Facts

(1869-1954)

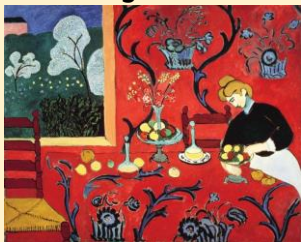


Colours and Feelings

Cutting

Using scissors to make straight or curved edges.

Tearing

Pulling apart to leave frayed or ragged edges.

Sticking

Using glue to attach things securely.

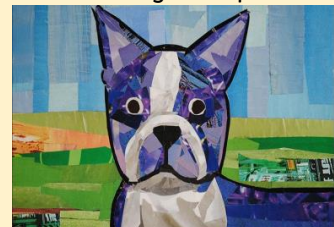
- Use a variety of man-made/natural materials.
