


Key Facts

Picasso was a very experimental artist, creating artwork in many different media and styles. Picasso's most famous art comes from when he worked as a Cubist – this meant seeing how a person or object looked from different directions and then including it all in the same picture.

Biography

Picasso was born in Malaga, in Spain, but moved to Paris when he was 23, as Paris was seen as an important artistic centre. He made friends with lots of other artists, sharing ideas. Picasso also became interested in art from continents other than Europe, which influenced his paintings.


Bowl of Fruit, Violin and Bottle (1914)

Key Vocabulary

- Collage** Artwork made by sticking materials onto a surface.
- Texture** How an object or image feels. Images may be created to look like they have a different texture.
- Overlap** Stick one picture slightly over the top of another.
