Dear Parents/ Carers,

The summer term is always extremely busy, please familiarise yourself with some reminders below and also some important dates for the term in the attached calendar.

Attendance and Punctuality



Alongside attendance, we closely monitor punctuality in school. A child who is late by 5 minutes each day loses 3.5 days of education across a full school year.

As a reminder, school starts at 8:45am every morning. From 8.50am children are marked as late on their register. It is important that children arrive in school on time as it supports them to learn good timekeeping and also reduces classroom disruption for the other children and themselves.

Term Time Holidays - Fines

On 7th March 2024 the Department For Educaation updated their guidance to schools 'Working together to improve school attendance' which will become statutory from August 2024. Under the new national framework, all schools will be required to consider a fine when a child has missed 10 or more sessions (5 days) for unauthorised reasons.

From Sepetmber 2024, parents who take their children out of school during term time for more than 5 (unauthorised) days, will be fined £80 per child, per parent, per absence.

Therefore from September 2024, we have made some amendments to our attendance policy:

Important SATs/ Screening Check Dates



Year 2 will be completing their SATs in small groups throughout the month of May. These are marked by our school staff and are used to help inform the teacher's end of Key Stage One assessment.

Year 6 SATs take place from **Monday 13th - Thursday 16th May**. These are externally marked and school will receive their results in early July. Results will be shared with parents within the children's annual reports.

Year 1 will be taking their Phonics screening check WB 10th June.

Year 4 will be taking their Multiplication check WB 3rd June - Friday 14th June.

Attendance and punctuality is vital on these dates.

Parking - Local Residents

Online Safety Parent Workshop



This term, we will be hosting an Online Safety workshop for parents. This will be delivered by our Safeguarding partners, Clennell. Date and time to be arranged.

We are dealing more and more with many incidents of children using various apps on their mobile phones and posting things online. This is taking up a great deal of the school day. As a school, we can educate the children through our computing, safeguarding and PSHE curriculums but this has to be a partnership between home and school.

Please do not assume that this does not affect your child, mobile phones and social networking are evolving constantly and if your child is using a device it is your responsibility to monitor this on a regular basis. We advise at least one parent/carer per family attend.

Course content will include:

- Knowledge and understanding around the online world.
- Information and guidance around parental controls.
- Knowledge around social media, and gaming. Thinking around age recommendations and why these are in place.
- An understanding of cyberbullying.

- Knowledge and understanding around the online risk children may face as they get older.
- Where parents can gain support and guidance from if they have any worries regarding the online world.
- Resources they can access following the session.

Parents will be able to sign up via ParentPay once a date is confirmed.

Water bottles/Hats/Sun lotion



Hopefully the weather will start to get warmer soon. Please remember that children should have a water bottle in school each day and as per school policy, this should contain **plain water only.**

On the hotter days, we recommend children bring a sun hat as we will be outside a lot and children should arrive to school wearing sun lotion. Children can bring a named bottle of sun lotion to keep in their drawer or school bag but they must be able to reapply this themselves.

New School Update



The school development should be going into planning by the end of April. If all goes to plan with this, construction will be due to commence on site October/November time. Further updates will follow as soon as we know more.

Fidgets and Toys



Children should not be bringing toys or fidgets into school. If it is felt your child would benefit from using a fidget in school, this should be discussed and agreed in advance with Mrs K Smith, school SENDcO.
