Communication, Language and Literacy

Core Book- Oliver's Vegetables

Over the weeks, the children will be introduced to Makaton signs for the different vegetables to support communication. 
In small groups, children will further explore the story by using the Tales Toolkit to discuss the characters, setting, problem and solution.
