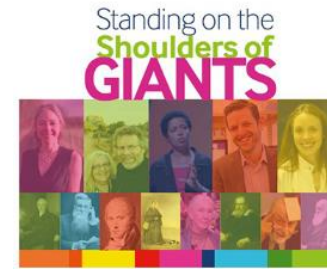


Knowledge Organiser – Standing on the Shoulders of Giants
