What have the ancient Greeks ever done for us?



City States

Ancient Greece was not a country. It was made up of city states. There were often battles between these city states but sometimes they would join together against a common enemy. Important city states of ancient Greece included Athens, Corinth and Sparta.

Alexander the Great's Empire

Independent city states existed for most of the **ancient** Greek period. However, near the end of this period, King Phillip II of Macedonia ruled over all of **ancient** Greece. Later, his son – Alexander the Great – took over the **empire** along with other lands that he conquered.
